## Scott Laurent Galleries 4th Anniversary Celebration

As in the process of creating art, we are a "work in progress." And so the process continues... From its humble beginnings on Virginia Avenue in 1991, Scott Laurent Galleries thrives in the Hidden Garden on Park Avenue, Winter Park.

The gallery's fourth anniversary, celebrated concurrently with Winter Park's prestigious Arts Festival, also marks the completion of Brenda Heim's tenure as Scott Laurent Galleries' first *Artist in Residence*. Brenda's show, "Transitions," opens on "Third Friday," March 17, for a 7-9 p.m. showcasing of her "Calligraphic Abstract Expressionism." (See *Photo inset*) This



transition also signals the installation of Kevin McLean as the next artist in the gallery's *Artist-In-Residence* program. Formalized by a two year contract, this program allows the artist a flexible work schedule, a scholarship to provide for art materials and supplies, gallery representation, and "hands-on" training in the marketing and sales of their art. Kevin's area of interest includes works in graphite pencil and acrylics. He also works closely with the Chuck Almand, Scott Laurent Galleries' staff interior

designer, especially in faux finishes, trompe l'oeil and wall treatments.

Scott Laurent Galleries is proud to welcome back "Maritza," this month's featured cover artist. Her watercolor and gold leaf "Memoirs Series" can be seen starting in April.
